## FROM THE RUNNING BOARD

The following summarizes information published in the Government Gazette and referred to SAVVA by the National Road Testing Association

- Left hand drive motor vehicles which were registered or licensed in the Republic into any person's name before 23 July 2004 may be driven on the country's roads and such motor vehicles may be disposed of or ownership transferred and they may be registered in the name of a new owner.

*(Let us hope that that is the final word in this controversy – Ed)*

- The duration of validity of roadworthy certificates for vehicles that change ownership has been changed from 6 months to 21 days
- New motor vehicles registered after 1 August 2010 must have number plates that are fitted with pop rivets or screws. If they cannot be fitted to the vehicle, they must be fitted to a bracket that complies with SANS 973.

*(They will then steal the number plate **AND** the part of the car to which is fitted – Ed)*

- Foreign licences are accepted if the person acquired the licence while he was not in SA for a period longer than 3 months. A foreign licence is valid in SA until it expires in the country of issue but not for longer than 5 years after the person received permanent residence in SA.

## MAINTAINING THE BREED

KEURBOOMS GYMKHANA 21 NOVEMBER BY RON HOLLIS

Sunday dawned clear and bright, removing fears of predicted light rain, and saw our shiny and varied convoy leaving Knysna Quays at 8h30, heading for the Dunes Hotel and Resort at Keurbooms – a pleasant run of about 45kms.

There, Graham and Sylvia Yendall had set out a driving challenge in the hotel parking area which involved negotiating a roundabout, several cones, and three parking “garages” in the correct sequence. Evidently this was cunningly configured to favour the Club Chairman's vehicle - see results below.

The event was run against the clock, with time penalties for touching cones or tackling any obstacle out of sequence. The tight course would clearly punish over-exuberance, so steady-but-controlled haste coupled with good technique and smooth coordination was the order of the day. Oh, so very easy to say....

Present were a total of 11 Club vehicles – 3 MGA's, 2 MGB's, 1 Midget, 1 MGC, 1 MGBGT, 1 V8 MGBGT, and 2 mid-engined TF's.
